



Discipline Policy for Mary Immaculate Star of the Sea School

Disciplinary Procedures and Policy

Pink Slips

Pink Slips are issued for serious offenses such as but not limited to the areas covered in the school Discipline Contract. Students who fail to follow rules as stated in the Discipline Contract will merit the following:

When a student receives **3 Pink Slips within one month** the student receives:

- ✓ First Offense - One day suspension

When a student receives **3 Pink Slips within a second month** the student receives:

- ✓ Second Offense - Three day suspension

When a student receives **3 Pink Slips within a third month** the student receives:

- ✓ Third Offense - Five day suspension

When a student has served a 5-day suspension, it will be up to the Administration and the Principal/Pastor to discuss options for the parents in an effort to change the student's behavior. Expulsion will occur only when a student refuses to cooperate with Mary Immaculate School Policy. This is an extreme measure. The school wants to work with the student and parent to find a positive means to correct negative behavior.

If a student again receives a total of three Pink Slips within a month – they are expelled.

White Slips

White slips are issued for minor offenses such as but not limited to:

- ✓ Out of uniform
- ✓ Lack of classroom materials
- ✓ Not following classroom rules
- ✓ Gum
- ✓ Not following the Electronic Device Policy*

White slips merit detention on Thursdays but do not go into the suspension/expulsion process.

***Electronic Policy**

All electronic devices (cell phones, I pods, Games) are to be left in the front office each morning and picked up at the end of the school day.

- ✓ First time caught with device - Verbal warning
- ✓ Second time caught with device - White Slip = Detention
- ✓ Third time caught with device - Device will be taken away and parents called
